
The ceremony ended with the throwing of hats and the taking of memorable photos.



Research gained a lot of interest among the conference participants. Her presentation generated a lot of interest among the conference participants,




professors - Professor Khatuna Makalatia, Nino Grdzelishvili and Natia Karumidze.


