



University of Kadi from India Visiting University Geomedi



From June 12 to June 30, academic staff and students of Kadi University from India visited the University Geomedi.

Within the framework of the Global Health Management program, two weeks were dedicated to gaining and sharing knowledge and experience, a series of lectures, seminars, and debates on various topics such as Introduction to Global Health Management, Personal Brand and Professional Growth Management, etc. The



participants visited the university campus, university clinics, and laboratories, organized a city tour.

Students of the Faculty of Medicine of University Geomedi were actively involved in seminar work and presented presentations. Workshops were held in the simulation clinic and anatomy laboratories.

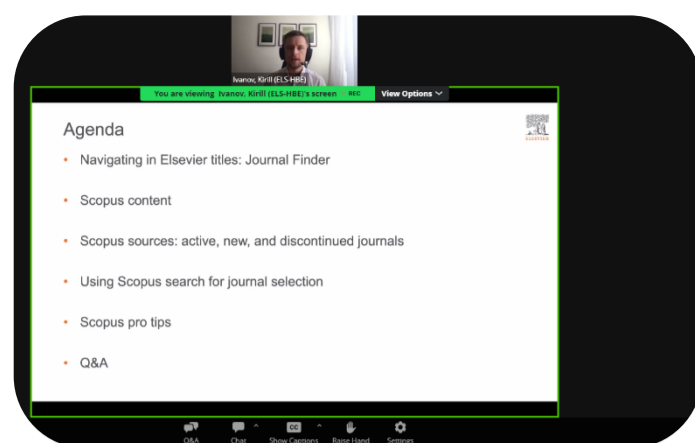
At the University Geomedi, webinars were held at the initiative of the library, which were related to the issues of using scientific databases. Webinars were attended by students, visiting and academic staff.

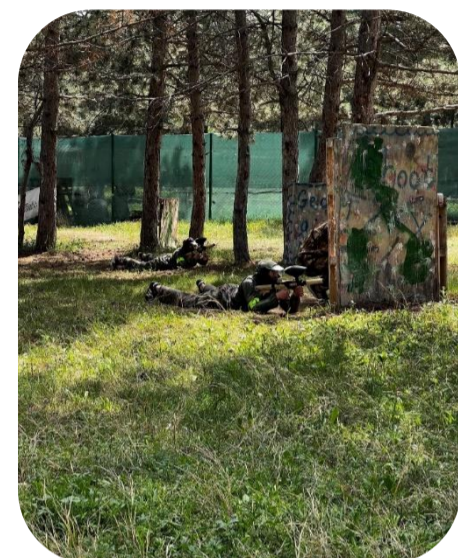

Book Presentation

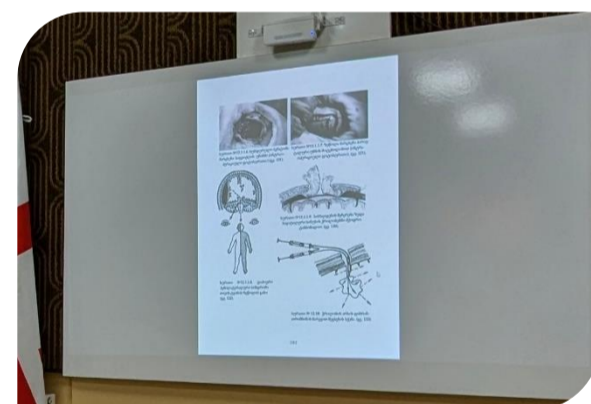


Teacher of University Geomedi - Zamir Kapanadze published the textbook "Military-Field Surgery". The presentation of the textbook was held at the University Geomedi in the conference hall on June 12, 2024.

It should be noted that there is no manual for this content in the Georgian language. The book discusses the tasks of military field surgery, one of the main directions of military medicine, in the case of modern military conflicts, large-scale and local wars, and the ways of their performance.

It presents important materials on injuries caused by modern weapons, their objective evaluations, peculiarities of surgical assistance organization, and tactics of "programmed multi-stage surgical treatment".

The presentation of the book was a great success.
