On October 4-6, 2021, an important scientific event, the Third International Symposium "Experimental and Clinical Medicine 2021" was organized by University Geomedi. Despite the pandemic, the delegates from several top Universities around the world were presented at the symposium.

On December 16, 2021, Student Theoretical and Practical online Conference on the topic: "Modern issues in Medicine and Management" was organized by the University Geomedi. On December 17, 2021, Scientific-Practical Conference for Professors on the topic: "Modern issues in Medicine and Management" was held. The researchers and professors from the University presented their researches and reports. All reports will be published in the University's Conference Proceedings.

On December 10, 2021, a seminar on "Towards Successful Scientific Research" was held at University Geomedi. The speakers were Assistant Professor Arian Matin and Associate Professor Tornike Khoshtaria. They discussed the following issues: How to plan and conduct successful scientific research and how to get published in a highly-rated, international journal. The seminar was conducted in English in a live and online format.

The second edition of Professor Teimuraz Tavkheldidze's book "General Pathology" has been published. The book reviews the issues of general pathological anatomy and general pathological physiology. The textbook was printed by University Geomedi. The book is intended for medical students and those interested in pathology. It is available at the University Library.

On November 19, 2021, Professor Revaz Lortkipanidze conducted a seminar on the topic: “Physics in Economics – for the State Thinking of the Modern Healthcare Business”. He discussed:

- The processes of information exchange in the electronic age and the ways for its protection
- The causes of the shadow economy and the optimization of managerial costs with network technologies
- Strategic business technologies and their mechanisms in economics

The seminar was conducted in a live and online format. After the presentation, a discussion was held.



On November 11, 2021, the Student Relations Office and the Faculty of Healthcare Economics and Management organized an online meeting with the successful alumni of the Teaching University Geomedi. Graduates, Beka Peradze, who is the Business Development Manager and the Director of the Laboratory Department at the company “Tbilisi Medici” and Nino Jibladze, Quality Assurance and Patient Safety Specialist at JSC “Evex Hospitals” shared their success stories with the students of Faculty of Healthcare Economics and Management. The graduates talked about how the knowledge, received at Geomedi helped them achieve their goals in career advancement. They also informed students about the ongoing vacancies in their company. At the end of the meeting, graduates answered students’ questions.



On October 29, 2021, a seminar “How to use electronic databases” was held at the initiative of the library for the professors and students. The topic was presented by the Deputy Director of the University Library-Nana Tsertsvadze. She spoke about the ways how to find and use materials in EBSCO and ELSEVIER databases in the field of medicine. The seminar was held at the University Conference Hall and also in an online format.

On October 22, 2021, a scientific seminar on the topic: “Information Technologies in Science” was held at the Teaching University Geomedi. The speaker was Tamar Khakhutashvili- President of the “Association for Science”. She discussed the planning and implementation of activities required for indexing a scientific journal in international scientific databases. A spirited discussion was held at the end of the seminar.

On October 15, 2021, as part of the Project Gimnasioni, an online presentation “Humans and Nature” was conducted at Teaching University Geomedi by the student of medical faculty- Niko Kadzania. At the presentation, he discussed medicine in ancient Georgia, the art of medicine preparation, folk remedies and the use of natural resources in medicine.



On November 12, 2021, Pankil Naimeshkumar Parikh, a student of the Faculty of Medicine, gave an online presentation on the topic: Sushruta: Father of Indian Medicine and Plastic Surgery as part of the project “Gimnasioni” seminars. He discussed surgical instruments, procedures, types of surgery and medicine, and the Indian medical system in general as described in the ancient Indian medical Sanskrit text “Sushruta Samhita”.

University professors and students attended the event. An interesting discussion was held at the end of the presentation.
