As part of the project "Gymnasioni" the students presented the following presentations in the conference hall of the University:

On March 18 - Ali Abbas, a student of the Faculty of Dentistry, delivered an interesting presentation on the topic: "Different Approach to Dentistry, New Discoveries, and Achievements." He informed us that with the help of bioengineering technologies it is possible to grow new, full-fledged teeth instead of damaged, destroyed, and missing teeth. Also spoke about the innovative achievements of the scientific research centers of Columbia, Japan, and Ukrainian Universities.



On April 15 - Sujit Jamesbhai Vaghela-Student of the Faculty of Medicine, delivered a presentation: "Energy Centers of Human body." He spoke of the uniqueness of each chakra, through which a person receives vital energy from the universe, nature, people, and even things.

On May 20 - Giorgi Korashvili-Student of the Faculty of Physical Rehabilitation and Medicine presented the topic: "Medicine in Ancient Egypt." The speaker introduced the audience to the Ebers Papyrus, which describes recipes, diagnoses, and tips for treating various diseases. He also talked about ancient Egyptian medicine. The events were attended by teachers and students. Presentations got great feedback from the attending public.



We passed University Geomedi in 2015 and soon realized that we had made the right choice, because we found a warm, friendly and efficient learning environment here, with a team of professionals and qualified lecturers.

On May 16-18, 2022, the Ninth International Communication Days Symposium "Communication Studies in the Digital Age" was held at Uskudar University in Istanbul, Turkey, in which many well-known specialists and professors of communication management, public relations, and media communications from world's leading universities participated. From University Geomedi, Professor Tornike Khoshtaria and Professor Archil Kapanadze were invited as speakers.

Professor Tornike Khoshtaria's presentation "Utilizing Consumer-Based Brand Equity Model to Investigate Brand Loyalty and Extensions in Football Clubs" focused on the



study of brand elements in football clubs, and discussed the factors that influence brand loyalty and purchasing intent.

Professor Archil Kapanadze's presentation: "Human Type Artificial Intelligence, Version 1.0", was about creating artificial intelligence using inductive logic operators through motivational, hierarchical filters.

Both presentations got great feedback from the attending public. Future cooperation plans with leading universities were outlined regarding the topics presented.

On April 5, 2022, at University Geomedia training "Use of Scientific Electronic Databases" was conducted for students and professors of the Faculty of Dentistry, Health Economics and Management, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation. A meeting on the same issue was held on April 14 for students of the Faculty of Medicine. Deputy Director of the University Library- Nana Tsertsvadze presented practical examples, of how to find and use resources in EBSCO and ELSEVIER scientific databases and discussed the following topics:

- Fundamentals of work and search in EBSCO and ELSEVIER;
- Importance of the scientific databases;
- Remote access capabilities to databases, etc.

On May 20, 2022, the Deputy Director of the Library, Nana Tsertsvadze, conducted online training for first-year English-speaking students of the Faculty of Medicine. The purpose of the meeting was to provide students with information about library services. Particular attention was paid to the use of international scientific databases and their access. She explained to students the ways to search databases. At the end of the meeting, she answered the students' questions.

On May 5, was held a webinar: Elsevier professional tools for working with scientific and technical information. Effective search in ScienceDirect and Scopus. **Maxim M. Filatov** - Elsevier's Key Information Solutions Consultant in Georgia presented the following topics:

- ✓ Effective information search in Scopus and ScienceDirect;
- ✓ Why it is important to use Elsevier Information Resources when searching for scientific information;
- ✓ Search rules in electronic databases;
- ✓ How Scopus can be useful for me as a scientist, etc.


The working language was English. The webinar was attended by University professors and students. At the end of the meeting, Maxim M. Filatov answered the questions from the audience.



On May 19 an online training program "Ouriginal" was conducted by the Library of University Geomedi for plagiarism prevention and to raise awareness. Teona Papiashvili, a representative of the Georgian Library Information Integrated Consortium 2017, a representative of the TSU National Scientific Library Training Center led the training. She discussed the functions of the similarity recognition program, how to check papers for plagiarism and analyse obtained results. The training was intended for academic staff and students. At the end of the meeting, a discussion was held.



Professor Tornike Khoshtaria, Dean of the Faculty of Healthcare Economics and Management of University Geomedi visited our partner university "American College" in the Republic of Northern Macedonia, as part of the Academic Staff Exchange Program. During the visit, Professor Tornike Khoshtaria met with the Rector of the Host University, Professor Marjan Bojadjiiev, and the Dean of the Faculty of Business, Professor Snežana Hristova. At the meeting, they discussed deepening the cooperation between the two universities in terms of teaching and research. The Honorary Consul of Northern Macedonia in Georgia also attended the meeting. He spoke about current issues in the field of higher education.







On May 28, 2022, with the initiative of the student self-government and the support of the university administration, an excursion to Kazbegi was organized, where students visited the Historical and Cultural sights.

A traditional picnic was held at the end of the tour, where students enjoyed spending time with a variety of fun activities. The excursion was educational as well as entertaining and it helped students to get to know each other better.



On April 5-8, 2022, at Teaching University Geomedi was held online open days. During the week, entrants had the opportunity to receive comprehensive information on educational programs and the learning process. They listened to faculty deans, and heads of the program,

and saw the university infrastructure and clinics in a live broadcast.

At University Geomedi, 3rd, 4th, and 5th-year students of the Faculty of Dentistry regularly review "5-minute" clinical cases. During the pandemic, this activity was conducted online.

The "5-minute" meetings are led by the doctors of the University Dental Clinic, in which they discuss interesting therapeutic, surgical, orthopedic, and orthodontic patient cases that are admitted to the clinic. Students give positive feedback to "5-minute" clinical case reviews saying that such activity enriches their practical and theoretical knowledge.
