project organizers for this extraordinary opportunity. The participants were awarded certificates at the end of the program.



On 11th of November, 2022, public lecture was held for administrative staff on the topic: "Personal Data Protection in Higher Education Institutions" The training was conducted by Lili Taniashvili, who is a Senior Lawyer of the Private Sector Supervision Department of the Personal Data Protection Service. Within the framework of the training, she discussed the importance of protection of personal data processing, legal bases of data processing, principles of data processing, data security and data subject rights.
