On February 3, 2023, a scientific seminar on the topic "Determination of antioxidant potential of Georgian medicinal plants and the prospects of their application for the treatment of pathologies associated with oxidative stress" was held in the conference hall of University Geomedi.

The speaker was Valentina Mittova, professor at the University Geomedi, and chief scientist of the Scientific-Research Institute of Experimental and Clinical Medicine. At the seminar, she spoke about the antioxidant potential of endemic plants in liver disease model, in mice. Within the framework of the seminar, the strategies for planning relevant experiments were also discussed.



A public lecture on the topic: "Diseases of the present gland and anomalies of the genital organs" was held at University Geomedi. The speaker was a Georgian urologist, doctor of medicine, professor and head of the urology service of the Pineo Medical Ecosystem - Mr. Avtandil Imadedze. The lecture was in the Georgian language. University professors and students attended the lecture.

The scientific paper “Hyperhomocysteinemia and pregnancy outcomes in women with polycystic ovary syndrome: A case-control study” was published in the “International Journal of Reproductive BioMedicine” within the framework of a scientific grant (GF-21-01), which was issued by the university Geomedi. The paper was co-authored by the affiliated professors of the University of Geomedi, Elene Asanidze and Zurab Tsetskhadze. The impact factor of the publishing journal is 1.424 and is indexed in PubMed Central, Scopus, and other scientific databases.

The scientific paper “Structural, optical and magnetic properties of Y-doped NiFe<sub>2</sub>O<sub>4</sub> nanoparticles prepared by simple co-precipitation method” was published in the scientific journal: “Solid State Sciences”. The article was co-authored by Valentina Mittova, an affiliated professor at University Geomedi. The impact factor of the journal is 3.752.

On January 20, 2023, a public lecture was held at University’s Conference Hall, with the initiative of The University Geomedi’s library and the organization “Gimnasioni”. The lecture was conducted by an academician of the National Academy of Georgia and economic science Dr. Tamar Asanishvili. The topic of the lecture was “History starts with Iberians”. The speaker talked about etymology of words, archeological artifacts, historical sources, etc.



The lecture aroused great interest among the audience. The presenter answered many different questions on the topic.

The webinar will help those interested to easily find the necessary information and full texts of scientific articles in the search engines of scientific databases. On February 15, another webinar on: "Facilitating the Use and Distribution of Electronic Databases" was held for the library staff by the same speaker. At the end of the Webinar, the presenter answered the questions on the topic.
