

Statistics of University of Geomedi graduates (employment rate according to received qualifications and academic development)

I. Statistics of the employment of the graduates of the Georgian and English-language educational program of the qualified medical doctor (in accordance with the received qualifications) and the continuation of studies at the next level

- 1. 12 Georgian-speaking graduates (25%) of 2020 are employed according to their qualifications, and 30% continued their studies in residency.
- 2. 16 graduates (25%) of 2020 are employed according to their qualifications, and 58% continued their studies in residency.
- 3. 9 graduates (30%) of 2021 are employed according to their qualifications, and 30% continued their studies at the residency.
- 4. 53 English-speaking graduates (42%) of 2021 are employed according to their qualifications, and 58% continued their studies in residency.
- 5. 25 Georgian-speaking graduates (40%) of 2022 are employed according to their qualifications, and 52% continued their studies at the residency.
- 6. 108 English-speaking graduates (50%) of 2022 are employed according to their qualifications, and 65% continued their studies in residency.

- 10. 48 English-speaking graduates (18%) of 2024 are employed according to their qualifications, and 60% continued their studies in residency.






II. Statistics of the employment of graduates of the one-level educational program of dentistry (in accordance with the obtained qualifications) and the continuation of studies at the next level


- 1. 10 graduates (42%) of 2014 are employed according to their qualifications, and 30% continued their studies at the residency.
- 2. 10 graduates (60%) of 2015 are employed according to their qualifications, and 50% continued their studies at the residency.
- 3. 11 graduates (52%) of 2016 are employed according to their qualifications, and 45% continued their studies at the residency.



IV. Statistics of employment of graduates of the master's educational program of physical medicine and rehabilitation (in accordance with received qualifications) and continuation of studies at the next level


- 1. 4 graduates (!00%) of 2017 are employed according to their qualifications, and 50% continued their master's studies.
